Texts on Anger and Sacrifice #1

Psalms 78 (Greek & Latin 77)

34 When He slew them, then they sought Him;
And they returned and sought earnestly for God.
35 Then they remembered that God their rock,
And the Most High God their Redeemer.
36 Nevertheless they flattered Him with their mouth,
And they lied to Him with their tongue;
37 For their heart was not steadfast with Him,
Nor were they faithful in His covenant.
38 But He, full of compassion, forgave iniquity And did not destroy.
Many times He averted His anger (אַלְהָשִׁיב אַפּל),
And did not stir up all His wrath;
39 For He remembered that they were flesh,
A breath that passes away and does not return.

- 2 Chronicles 29 ⁴ Then [King Hezekiah] brought in the priests and the Levites, and gathered them in the East Square, ⁵ and said to them: "Hear me, Levites! . . ⁸ Therefore the wrath of the Lord fell upon Judah and Jerusalem, and He has given them up to trouble, to desolation, and to jeering, as you see with your eyes. . . .
- 1º "Now it is in my heart to make a covenant (לְכְרוֹת בְּרִית) with the Lord God of Israel, that His fierce wrath may turn away from us (וְיָשׁוּב מִכֶּנוּ חֲרוֹן אַפּוֹי). ¹¹ My sons, do not be negligent now, for the Lord has chosen you to stand before Him, to serve Him, and that you should minister to Him and burn incense."

Jeremiah 18 ⁸ if that nation against whom I have spoken turns (בְּשָׁב) from its evil, I will relent of the disaster that I thought to bring upon it.

Jonah 3 ⁷ Let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste anything; do not let them eat, or drink water. ⁸ But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily to God; yes, let everyone turn (וְיָשֶׁבוּיִ) from his evil way and from the violence that is in his hands. ⁹ Who can tell if God will turn (יְשׁוּב) and relent, and turn from His fierce anger (וְשָׁב מִחֲרוֹן אַפּוֹי) so that we may not perish?

Psalms 51 (Greek & Latin 50)

¹⁰ Create in me a clean heart, O God,

And renew a steadfast spirit (וְרוּחֵ נְכוֹן) within me.

¹¹ Do not cast me away from Your presence,

And take Your holy spirit (רוּתַ קָרְשָׁךְ) from me.

¹² Restore to me the joy of Your salvation,

And let a noble spirit (רוּחַ נְדִיבֶה) uphold me.
